races, one flat, and three pony races that kick off at 10:30am. These races are part of Delaware Valley Point-toPoint series, the Maryland Steeplechase Governor's Cup Series, and the only waterfront point to point races!

After the morning pony races, there will be a will be a special Junior Field Master Chase, followed by the
Wicomico Hunt Club Hound Parade, Brandywine Valley Driving Club Carriage Parade, and the judging of the
Tailgate & Hat Contests. Paddock time for the afternoon timber races is 12:45, with a 1pm Post time. The
featured race, The Wicomico Hunt Cup, an open event over the three-mile Mount Harmon Course, goes to the
paddock at 2:45, with Post Time at 3pm. Don't miss our Point to Point Marketplace with Open Air Food Court,
Tavern and Marketplace with artisan and equestrian vendors and merchants for all to enjoy.

Mount Harmon Plantation is located on the Eastern Shore of Maryland, and features a restored 18<sup>th</sup> century manor house, formal boxwood garden, plantation outbuildings, miles of scenic nature trails, 200-acre nature preserve, and stunning Tidewater setting. Racecourse was completed for our April 2022 inaugural event, and includes 11 timber fences set on established turf. Over 1,000 attended the inaugural point to point April 16, 2022 to rave reviews. Be sure to join us for a great day of spring thoroughbred racing in the countryside overlooking the Sassafras River.
