

MOUNT HARMON PLANTATION Walking Tours & Day Passes FAQs

What is included in the Walking Tour?

Our new Walking Tour includes guided tours of the Carriage House Visitor Center, first floor of the historic Georgian Manor House, and Plantation Outbuildings-Colonial Kitchen, recreated smoke house and slave quarters.

Access to our grounds and nature trails for exploring, hiking, and picnicking are included with your tour until 5 pm.

When are the Walking Tours available?

Walking Tours are available Thursdays-Sundays, 10am-3pm, with tours on the hour and our last tour is at 2pm. One Group Per Tour.

How long are the walking tours?

Our walking tours are approximately one hour, with 3 tour stops, each about 20 minutes. We suggest allowing additional time to explore and enjoy our beautiful grounds after your tour.

How do I make a reservation for a walking tour?

We prefer you book [online](#) in advance for the safest touchless payment method by following the prompts on our [Tours and Day Passes page](#). Click Book Walking Tour Now link, and on calendar select date and time for tour, and enter admission for each, scroll down to book now. You will receive e-confirmation good for admission.

How do I check availability for a walking tour on the same day?

Either call us at 410-275-8819 or send us an [email](#) at info@mountharmon.org with your name, number in your party, along with the date and time you'd like to tour, and we will get back to you to confirm your tour.

Are walk ins available for the walking tour?

Walk ins are welcome for tours on space available basis and can be purchase at visitor center (on tour days Thursdays-Sundays, 10am-3pm, last tour at 2pm). Or call 410-275-8819 for same day availability. Reserve ahead for best availability.

What are your restrictions?

While our walking tours are primarily outside, when we enter buildings we do require masks to be worn when inside. We also request that you follow social distancing. At our historic site, we practice leave no trace guidelines.

What is included in the Day Passes?

With our new Mount Harmon Day Pass you can enjoy and explore our beautiful grounds, gardens, picnic areas, 5 miles of nature trails, canoe and kayak launch, and 200-acre nature preserve. Site Map with points of interest and nature trails included.

How do I purchase a day pass?

Day Passes can be purchased [online](#) in advance by following the prompts on the [Tours and Day Passes page](#). Click "Book Day Pass Now" and select date for day pass, enter admission for each, scroll down to book now. You will receive e-confirmation good for admission.

Thursday through Sunday, 10-3, day passes can be purchased at our visitor center. Site maps and gift shop are available on tour days at our visitor center as well.

When are Day Passes available?

Day Passes are available daily 9am-5pm.

When are buildings and facilities open?

Please Note: Visitor Center Exhibits, Gift Shop & Restrooms, Manor House, and Outbuildings are only open on tour days: Thursdays-Sundays, 10am-3pm. Our pool house facility (across from colonial kitchen) has restrooms open daily 9am-5pm.

Can I purchase food onsite?

No, however visitors are welcome to bring a picnic lunch to enjoy at our picnic areas.

What is the cost for Walking Tours?

Walking Tour Admission is: \$10 adults, \$8 students/seniors.
Members Free Children under 5 Free (reservations still required).

What is the cost for Day Passes?

Day Pass Admission is: \$10 adults, \$8 students/seniors (Tour Not Included).
Members & Children under 5 Free

What is the cost for Mount Harmon members?
