### **Announcing the Mount Harmon Wicomico Hunt Point to Point April 10!**

In conjunction with Wicomico Hunt Club, Mount Harmon Plantation is hosting the inaugural running of the Mount Harmon-Wicomico Point-to-Point races on April 10, 2022. Plan to join us for a great day of spring races at one of Maryland's most beautiful historic sites featuring ten races, including six timber races, one flat, and the program kicks off at 10:30 with three pony races. These races are part of Delaware Valley Point-to-Point series, and the Maryland Steeplechase Governor's Cup Series.

Following the morning pony races, there will be a parade of the Wicomico Hunt Club Hounds, an exciting Antique Carriage Parade, and the judging of the all-important Tailgate Competition. Paddock time for the afternoon timber races is 12:45, with a 1pm Post time. The feature race, The Wicomico Hunt Cup, an open event over the three-mile Mount Harmon Course, goes to the paddock at 2:45, with Post Time at 3pm. Don't miss our Point to Point Marketplace with Open Air Food Court, Tavern & Marketplace with artisan and equestrian vendors and merchants.

The Mount Harmon Plantation, one of Maryland's most beautiful historic sites, is located on the Eastern Shore of Maryland, and features a restored 18<sup>th</sup> century manor house, a formal boxwood garden, nature trails on 200 acres of pristine open space in a waterfront setting. Racecourse work began in April 2021, and includes 11 timber fences set on established turf.
