

Wicomico Hunt History

The club was founded by a small group of Salisbury, MD sportsmen in the early 1920's, who wanted to experience the thrill of the chase. The club has continued to today due to the persistent efforts of a larger group of dedicated riders and sporting enthusiasts, now numbering over 100. Each have devoted countless hours to the continu-

ation of the ancient sport of fox chasing on the Delmarva Peninsula, which began in 1650 when Lord de la Brooke imported the red fox and foxhounds from England.

The club took a hiatus during World War II, but was revitalized by a group that included Hamilton P. Fox, a returning veteran, and with others has continued to prosper and expand since then. Ham Fox served as huntsman for many years until the club had enough resources to allow it to hire a professional huntsman. He was a consummate horseman, competent huntsman and person who led by example, never shying away from a tall fence or an issue that needed to be resolved.

Ham would be thrilled to know that today's 10th race is THE WICOMICO HUNT CUP. It is an Open Race over timber fences and the winner will receive the cup and the \$2500 cash prize given by Dr. Leo & Liz Courtney. If you have a bit of daring and love to ride over beautiful farms you would otherwise never see, come join us to learn about our sport and our club at wicomicohunt.com. 


Equestrian History at Mount Harmon

Horse racing has deep roots on the Sassafras!



In the late 1700s, Sydney George Jr. of Mount Harmon had a stable of 60 racing horses and a private race course. Point to point racing became popular in the 18th century in Ireland and England, and throughout the mid-Atlantic region by English and Irish immigrants to the area that brought their favorite traditions that continue today.

In 1830, when the MD Jockey Club received a new charter from Congress, General Thomas Marsh Foreman was elected president. General Foreman lived on Rose Hill, the neighboring property to Mount Harmon.

Steeplechase Racing

For thousands of years, the human relationship between people and horses has endured and is deeply rooted in the origins of civilization and culture. Our relationship with horses has been paramount in every aspect of our evolution as humans. From agriculture, transportation, warfare and quality of life, horses have been side by side with mankind for over 10,000 years!

Steeplechase and Point-to-Point racing trace their roots to Ireland in the 18th century. A wager was placed between Cornelius O'Callaghan and Edmund Blake in 1752 to determine whose horse was faster from one church steeple to another. One way to look at the concept is like this, "My horse against your horse from this point to that point as fast as you can over any obstacle that gets in your way." The sport became very popular in Great Britain and Ireland, and eventually made its way to the United States.

Steeplechase racing came to America in the early 1800's with Irish and English immigrants relocating to the Mid-Atlantic region. Early records show that a race meet was held near Washington DC in 1834. Steeplechase racing became popular in 11 states and is concentrated in MD, VA, DE, PA and NY.

This type of racing became a popular rivalry between Fox Hunting Clubs in the United States. The most famous steeplechase race in America is the Maryland Hunt Cup, which started in 1894 as a contest between The Elkridge Fox Hunting Club and the Green Spring Fox Hunting Club. The Hunt Cup still runs in Maryland on the last Saturday in April.

Today, Steeplechase racing is alive and well in the United States. The National Steeplechase Association is located just up the road in Fair Hill, Maryland.






